Macomb County Concealed Weapon Licensing Board Announces Temporary Change in Procedures

With the recent Concealed Weapon law changes of Public Act 719 of 2002, effective July 1, 2003, the Macomb County Concealed Weapon Licensing Board has made the decision to not accept CCW applications from June 1, 2003 to July 1, 2003. The Michigan State Police have changed the permit and application form and they will not be available until late June.

The changes include:

- a total fee of \$105.00 for new and renewal applicants, which includes fingerprinting, to be paid to the Macomb County Clerk's Office
- fingerprints can be taken at any local police department or Macomb County Sheriff Department
- permit term has gone from three (3) years to five (5) years
- applicants will be required to fire at least 30 rounds of ammunition during the training program.

"This will benefit the concealed weapon holders when they want to reapply or new applicants because they will be able to receive five-year permits", said Sabaugh.

Applications for concealed weapons can be picked up at the Macomb County Clerk's Office, any local police department, or the Macomb County Sheriff Department. Fees can be paid with cash, check, money order or credit card.
