

# 2022 FILING REQUIREMENTS FOR MACOMB COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

**Two 6-year terms ending 12/31/2028**

## **WHERE TO FILE**

Macomb Community College Board of Trustees candidates must file with the Macomb County Clerk's Office, Elections Department, which is located at 32 Market Street, Mount Clemens.

## **WHAT TO FILE**

- Affidavit of Identity and Receipt of Filing, in duplicate.
- Community College Nominating Petitions containing a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 100 signatures from qualified and registered electors in the Macomb Community College District **OR** a \$100.00 nonrefundable filing fee, in lieu of nominating petitions.
- Nominating Petitions and the Affidavit of Identity are available at the Macomb County Clerk's Office, Elections Department.

## **WHEN TO FILE**

Candidates must file no later than **4:00 p.m. on July 26, 2022.**

## **CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL**

Candidates must withdraw, in writing, with the filing official by 4:00 p.m. on July 29, 2022.

Candidates who withdraw from the November General Election and have paid a \$100 filing fee will **not** be refunded the filing fee.

## **CAMPAIGN FINANCE**

All candidates are required to comply with the Campaign Finance Act filing requirements. Information is available in our office Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

## **MCC BOARD OF TRUSTEES QUALIFICATIONS**

Must be at least 18 years of age, a citizen of the United States, and a qualified and registered elector of the district by the filing deadline.
