Campbell twelve hundred and ninety two and Rudolph Manning twelve hundred and ninety six and Warren King eleven hundred and fifty nine Abner Pratt eleven hundred and fifty two David Johnson eleven hundred and fifty four and the whole number of votes cast for circuit Judge was two thousand four hundred and fifty and Sanford M. Egan got two thousand four hundred and ten and at least one the whole number of votes given for Regents was two thousand four hundred and fifty seven and they were given for George W. Pack twelve hundred and eighty seven and James B. Eldridge eleven hundred and seventy six
