Statement of votes given in the County of Macomb and State of Michigan on Monday the sixth day of April A.D. 1868 for and against the adoption of the Constitution of 1867: and of the votes given for the propositions relative to Annual or Biennial Sessions of the Legislature to stand as Section 8 of Article 5 of said Constitution; and also of the votes given for and against the proposed section relative to Prohibition to stand as Section 34 of said Article 5 as passed in Convention convened at the Capital in the City of Lansing agreeable to Act No. 41 of the Legislature of 1867 and submitted to the Electors of this State for their adoption or rejection in compliance with the provisions of the said Schedule of the said Constitution

The whole number of votes given for and against the proposed

Section 34 of Article 5 was Three thousand four hundred and seven and they were cast as follows viz One thousand four hundred and thirty were cast for "Prohibition Yes" and One thousand nine hundred and seventy seven were cast for "Prohibition No"
